Shinny Ice Policies

By signing in and stepping on the ice, the skater or coach agrees to the policies set out below. The below policies allow us to continue to provide shinny ice, and maintain safe and productive training sessions.

- Anyone wishing to step onto the ice must be currently registered with Skate Canada: both coaches and skaters
- Non-Skate Oakville Members must have a current Skate Canada number available and visiting club information
- Skaters must be passed CanSkate Stage 5 to be eligible for shinny ice.
- Beginner skaters should be supervised while on the ice by their coach for their safety.
- Payment must be made <u>before</u> stepping onto the ice, if you skate over the time paid, you are expected to return to the office and pay for the extra time.
- The cost of shinny ice is **per hour or portion of,** this means if you are on the ice for 1 hour and 15 minutes, you must pay for 2 hours of shinny ice
- No food, gum, or drinks are allowed on the ice. Water in plastic containers at the boards is acceptable.
- Absolutely no cell phone usage on the ice.
- All garbage, tissues, etc. are to be properly disposed of in the garbage bin behind the boards.
- Courtesy and good sportsmanship to coaches and fellow skaters is expected at all times.
- Skates are to be put on in the designated change rooms. Guards are to be worn at all times off the ice.
- Skaters are to be moving at all times on the ice, unless waiting for music to begin. If you need to talk to a friend/coach, do so at the boards or step off the ice.
- Coaches are to coach from the boards whenever possible.
- If you should fall, please get up quickly and move out of the way of other skaters.
- Spins should be done at the centre ice.
- Jumps should be done at the ends of the ice. Please leave these ends clear for jumpers.
- Skaters are to give right of way to those doing their program or in a lesson with a coach.
- Skaters doing their program must wear a solo sash during the program.
- When the Zamboni doors open, leave the ice immediately. Do not enter ice surface until the Zamboni doors are closed again.
- Always be aware of those skating around you!
