EDGE Gala Volunteer Information

The EDGE Gala is a yearly event held at the Sixteen Mile Sports Complex in November. This event showcases the programs that the EDGE Synchronized Skating teams have been working on, as well as showcases some of our singles, pairs, and dance team skaters.

The volunteer coordinator for the event will be in touch with you closer to the date of the event. You will be provided with a volunteer lanyard when you sign in and must return the lanyard when you sign out.

Admissions – you will be stationed at the admissions table. This is where guests will purchase their tickets and programs. Any VIP guests will also pick up their tickets here if they did not do so in advance at the office. You will be informed of the ticket and program price upon arriving for your shift.

50/50 – you will be helping to sell 50/50 tickets to those attending the Gala. You will be informed of the price for tickets upon arriving for your shift. You may be selling in the hallway outside Rink #1 or inside Rink #1 to guests who may already be seated.

Security – You will be given a designated area to watch over to ensure that anyone trying to enter to watch the Gala has a ticket, or that no one is going back into the dressing room area if they do not belong back there. Please be diligent if you are working at an entrance to Rink #1 as this is a fundraiser for the EDGE teams.

Bake Sale – You will be selling baked good and candy items provided by the families of the EDGE teams. Each item will be marked with a price upon arrival.

Ice Captains – You will be stationed at the entrance or exit doors for Rink #1, or in the hallway between rinks #1 and #2 and ensure that skaters are lined up ahead of time and ready to go on the ice at the proper time. You will open and close the doors to the ice for the skaters. You may be responsible for taking their skating guards and putting them in a box, or giving them back the box with their guards.

Silent Auction – you will be stationed at the silent auction tables. You will help with setting up the prizes on the table, watch over the table to ensure prizes stay put, and assist with taking payments and handing out the prizes to the winners. Once the silent auction is announced as closed, the bid sheets must be highlighted with the winners name. A credit card slip must be filled out for anyone paying with Mastercard or Visa. Amex is not accepted.
